A local law Accepting the Right and Responsibility for the Enforcement
of the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code

1. In accordance with New York State Executive Law, Section 381 (2), the town of Wayland hereby reclaim the rights, responsibilities, powers and duties to enforce the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code commencing September 1, 1984.
2. Further, in accordance with New York State Executive Law, Section 381(2), the Town of Wayland acknowledges herewith that it may relinquish the same rights, responsibilities, powers, and duties at a later date by repealing this local law before July 1 of the prior year.
3. Local Law 1 of the Town of Wayland, enacted on June 13, 1983, is hereby repealed.

BE IT ENACTED this 13th day of August, 1984 by the Town Board of the Town of Wayland, Steuben County, New York, to be effective immediately.

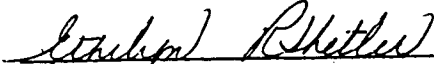
