Village as follows:

Section 1. Every ordinance and every local law and every amendment or supplement to an ordinance or local law hereafter adopted or approved by the town board of the Town of Wayland which is or may be required to be published in one or more newspapers in order to make such ordinance, local law, amendment or supplement effectual shall not be so published in full, but it shall be sufficient to publish in such newspaper or newspapers a notice setting forth the title thereof, a brief description of the provisions thereof and a statement that the full text thereof is on file and may be inspected in the office of the town clerk.

Section 2. This local law shall supersede in their application to the Town of Wayland the provisions of Sections 133, 264 and 265 of the town law relating to publication only of an ordinance or local law, amendment or a supplement to an ordinance adopted or approved by the town board.

Section 3. This local law shall be subject to referendum on petition pursuant to Section 24 of the municipal home rule law and shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the secretary of state in accordance with Section 27 of such law.
