A local law REPEALING LOCAL LAW # 2 OF THE YEAR 1995 REGULATING JUNK YARDS AND THE STORAGE OF JUNK AND JUNK CARS IN THE TOWN OF WAYLAND, STEUBEN COUNTY, NEW YORK

Be it enacted by the TOWN BOARD
of the

of WAYLAND as follows:

Section 1. This law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted the Town in Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and in Section 130(15) of the Town Law.

Section 2. The Town Board enacted Local Law #2 of the Year 1995 REGULATING JUNK YARDS AND THE STORAGE OF JUNK AND JUNK CARS IN THE TOWN OF WAYLAND, STEUBEN COUNTY, NEW YORK, also known as the "JUNK LAW" of the Town of Wayland, at a town board meeting following a public hearing June 19, 1995. It was filed with the Department of State June 26, 1995.

Section 3. The Town Board hereby repeals Local Law #2 of the Year 1995 REGULATING JUNK YARDS AND THE STORAGE OF JUNK AND JUNK CARS IN THE TOWN OF WAYLAND, STEUBEN COUNTY, NEW YORK, also known as the "JUNK LAW" of the Town of Wayland, and any amendments, if any, thereto.

Section 4. Should any section or provision of this Local Law be decided by the Courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not effect the validity of the Law as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon adoption and filing as required by the Laws of the State of New York.

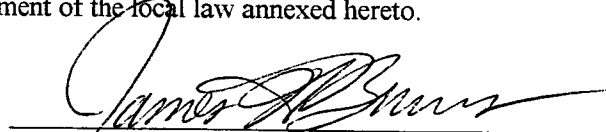
