A local law ESTABLISHING THE DAY FOR COMPLAINTS WITH RESPECT TO
ASSESSMENTS

Be it enacted by the TOWN BOARD of the

1. TITLE

This law shall be known as the "Grievance Day Law of the Town of Wayland."

2. AUTHORITY

This law is enacted pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law section 10 and Real Property Tax Law section 524.

3. PURPOSE

This law is enacted to establish the day for the meeting of the board of assessment review to hear complaints with respect to assessments.

4. DAY ESTABLISHED

The day established hereby for the meeting of the board of assessment review to hear complaints with respect to assessments shall be the first Thursday following the fourth Tuesday in May of every year.

5. SEVERABILITY

If any clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section, or part of this local law is adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not effect, impair, or invalidate the remainder this law, but such judgment shall be confined

in its effect to the clause, sentence, subdivision, paragraph, section, or part directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect upon its adoption and filing in the office of the Secretary of State as required by law, and publication of notice of this law in the official newspaper of the Town of Wayland.
