A local law Games of Chance Law of the Town of Wayland

Section 1. TITLE. This local law shall be known as the Games of Chance Law of the Town of Wayland.

Section 2. DEFINITIONS. "Authorized Organization" shall mean an authorized organization as defined in Paragraph 4 of Section 186 of the General Municipal Law. "Games of Chance" shall mean a game of chance as defined in Paragraph 3 of Section 186 of the General Municipal Law.

Section 3. GAMES OF CHANCE AUTHORIZED. Authorized organizations, may upon obtaining a license from the Town Clerk, conduct games of chance within the Town of Wayland as provided in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law and as provided further in this local law. Such games of chance shall be conducted in accordance with the laws of the State of New York and with the rules and regulations adopted by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board and pursuant to this local law.

Section 4. RESTRICTIONS. The conduct of games of chance shall be subject to the restrictions imposed by Section 189 of the General Municipal Law.

Section 5. SUNDAY GAMES. Games of Chance may be conducted on Sunday pursuant to this local law. However, no games of chance shall be conducted on Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or New York's Eve.

Section 6. ENFORCEMENT. The Sheriff of the Steuben County Sheriff's Department shall exercise control over and supervision of all games of chance conducted under duly authorized license. The Sheriff shall have all those powers and duties set forth in and for the enforcement of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law.

Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the office of the Secretary of State, following its approval by majority of the qualified voters of the Town of Wayland voting on a proposition therefore, at a general election held pursuant to the provisions of Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

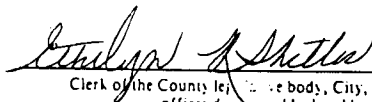

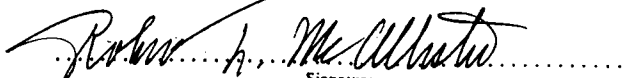
