1. The annual fee for each dog license issued pursuant to Article 7 of the New York State Agriculture and Markets Law is hereby increased for each spayed or neutered dog from Five Dollars (\$5.00) to Ten Dollars (\$10.00).
2. The annual fee for each dog license issued pursuant to Article 7 of the New York State Agriculture and Markets Law is hereby increased for each unspayed or unneutered dog from Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to Fifteen Dollars (\$ 15.00).
3. Such additional fees shall be the property of the Town of Wayland and shall be used in accordance with subdivision 4 (a) of Section 110 of the New York State Agriculture and Markets Law.
4. This law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
